The political background to the Achaemenid Empire remains elusive and the subject of important shifts in scholarly consensus over the past four decades. Specifically, scholarly perspectives regarding the importance of the Medes as imperial predecessors of the Persians, the dynastic unity of Cyrus II and Darius I. This presentation provides an overview of the changing paradigms, and counter theories, along with a call for a more synthetic and less radical approach to the sources.

Reza Zarghamee is both a practicing attorney and a Fellow in Ancient History at the University of St. Andrews where he obtained his Ph. D. for a thesis, entitled "Mythical Models: Reflections of Iranian Traditions in the Classical Accounts of Median and early Achaemenid Royalty." He is the author of "Discovering Cyrus" (2013), a historical biography of Cyrus the Great.
